Progress to Date

Since 1997, we have provided more than \$1 million for medication, training, scholarships, and small medical equipment to several pediatric cancer treatment centers in Egypt. The pediatric oncology hospitals we support are affiliated with the following universities: Ain-Shams, Alexandria, Mansoura, Zagazig, Asyut, Menya and Nasser Institute. We also provide support for the Health and Hope Oasis in Wadi-El-Natroun; Egypt's first supportive care center for children with cancer and their families.
